DEFINITION OF RAGGING

Ragging includes any act that causes physical or psychological harm, fear, shame, or embarrassment to a student, including verbal abuse, bullying, or coercion.

DETAILED PUNISHMENTS

- Suspension from classes
- Expulsion from college
- Cancellation of admission
- Withholding scholarships
- Debarment from exams
- Rustication for a period
- FIR filing and police action
- Imprisonment under criminal law (in severe cases)

LEGAL PROVISIONS

Under UGC Regulations 2009 and IPC provisions:

- Section 294 IPC – Obscene acts
- Section 323/325 – Causing hurt/grievous hurt
- Section 506 – Criminal intimidation
- Section 509 – Insulting modesty

Ragging is treated as a punishable criminal offence.

MANDATORY AFFIDAVIT

All students and parents must submit an Anti-Ragging Affidavit at admission confirming they will not engage in ragging activities.
